The ASQ Research Seed Grants Program provides initial funding for innovative research projects. It seeks to nurture cutting-edge ideas and facilitate early-stage research projects consistent with the organisational commitments, focus areas and strategies outlined in Anglicare's 2023-25 Strategic Plan.

FUNDING

In 2024-2025, there is a total of \$80,000 available for seed funding research projects. Funding of up to \$20,000 (excl. GST)1 which may be taken over 1.5 years (max.), will be provided to each successful applicant (individual or team) 2,3.

ELIGIBILITY

ASQ will consider applications that:

- meet eligibility requirements set out in the Research Seed Grants Application Guidelines
- support ASQ's strategic priorities
- are deemed by the review panel to be consistent with the ASQ's vision, mission and values.

All seed grants applications must involve at least 1 x ASQ staff as co-researcher. Any interested ASQ staff can collaborate with a university researcher or research team and apply for funding. Please contact research@anglicaresq.org.au for discussion of your proposal before submission.

HOW TO APPLY

Step 1. Complete the application: Applicants must read the Research Seed Grants Application Guidelines prior to completing the Application Form. Complete the application form and attach any required documents.

Step 2. Submit the application: Email the completed application and attachments to ASQ Research and Advocacy team at research@anglicaresq.org.au.
