RE: Village Manly Upcoming Construction Noise And Reminder

Dear residents and loved ones,

I am writing to advise you of additional construction noise at our home **commencing on Thursday 05 June at 3pm and from 7am on Friday 06 June** outside of the front administration office.

The Village Manly construction team will be using saw cutting and vacuum excavation as part of the upgrade works to our administration building. Pedestrian access to the administration office will remain open over the next two days as per usual.

All construction noise impacts will be managed in accordance with Council requirements and restrictions. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause and thank you for your understanding.

PLEASE NOTE: A FRIENDLY REMINDER

We would also like to remind residents that sanitary items such as pads and tampons must not be flushed down the toilet at any time.

As construction continues, our home is operating on a temporary sewage pump, and we ask you to please be mindful when using the toilet. Sanitary items will not break down when flushed and can cause water and waste blockages in the sewage system, leading to significant repair costs and construction delays.

Please do not flush the following items down the toilet:

1. Sanitary items including pads, tampons and incontinence underwear
2. Baby wipes, wet wipes, Q-Tips and cotton balls
3. Paper towels – paper towels are not designed to dissolve like toilet paper, so it's always best to throw these in a rubbish bin.
