Supporting Youth, Strengthening Tomorrow

Every night, thousands of young people in Queensland are without a safe place to call home. Almost a quarter of all people experiencing homelessness in Australia are aged 12–24.

Anglicare Southern Queensland is responding with the Youth Homelessness Accommodation Project, a \$14 million purpose-built facility in the Logan region custom designed to support young people (aged 16-25) who are either experiencing, or at risk of experiencing, homelessness.

The Youth Homelessness Accommodation facilities will include:



30 modern units designed for dignity and safety



24/7 on-site support from caring professionals



Wrap-around services such as counselling, education, employment pathways, and life-skills mentoring

We know that with stable housing and the right support network, young people can positively change their life trajectory by securing employment, education, and long-term housing.







The impact you can make

\$500 - helps furnish a room

Help cover the cost of a bed, bedding and basic furnishings to make a room welcoming and safe.

\$1000 – helps provide a pathway to stability

Helps to provide a young person with the tools for independence such as life skills training, mentoring and job readiness programs.

\$5000 - helps create communal spaces

Supports the fit-out of shared living areas where young people can cook, eat, and connect in safety.

\$10,000 – helps provide wraparound support

Creates the stability needed for young people to thrive, reconnect with community, and build a future of possibility. This is an investment in hope, directly changing the trajectory of a young person's life.
