#### RE: Upcoming construction at EM Tooth and impact to access in our home

Dear residents and loved ones,

As part of our ongoing communication, I am writing to advise you of some upcoming construction work changes that may temporarily impact your access around our home.

#### Partial reopening of Oceana Terrace driveway and limited car parking spaces

- The Oceana Terrace driveway has partially reopened as marked below in blue. The temporary
  driveway will now be closed for public access and utilised as a construction entry, only. Please
  note, directional signage is in place to communicate this.
- We are aware that the new entry point may be a longer walk for some visitors. If you require any assistance, please don't hesitate to contact reception.
- With the Oceana Terrace driveway partially reopening, we now have a smaller number of parking spaces for visitors. Please note reserved carparks are for mobility constrained visitors only.
   Street parking along Oceana Terrace will remain available for other visitors.
