## Event overview

**The Partners in Purpose Lunch will be held on Wednesday 6 May 2026, from 12.00pm to 3.00pm, at the iconic Victoria Park Golf Complex, Herston.**

Taking place at a pivotal moment for Brisbane, this event will be among the final major gatherings at Victoria Park before the site is transformed for the 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games. The setting reflects the focus of the conversation — how leadership decisions made today can shape a lasting social legacy for Queensland’s young people and communities.

With a focus on Brisbane 2032, guests will hear an engaging panel discussion on Mobilising Corporate Leadership for Social Impact Ahead of 2032, exploring how business and philanthropy can work alongside the not-for-profit sector to accelerate homelessness prevention, strengthen youth housing pathways, and contribute to a socially responsible Games legacy.

The discussion will be facilitated by journalist and ABC Radio Breakfast host Loretta Ryan, and will bring together respected leaders and purpose-driven organisations.

Guests will enjoy a two-course lunch with a three-hour drinks package, lived-experience insights, valuable networking opportunities, exclusive raffle and auction prizes, and recognition of corporate partners helping to create safer futures for Queenslanders.

Funds raised will directly support Anglicare Southern Queensland’s Housing and Homelessness services, making this a meaningful opportunity to connect, collaborate, and drive real change.



# About Anglicare's Housing & Homelessness portfolio

Anglicare Southern Queensland supports individuals and families experiencing homelessness or housing insecurity through a continuum of services that provide safety, stability and pathways to long-term independence. We work alongside people at every stage of their housing journey, from crisis response through to sustained housing and independence.

## **Crisis and supported accommodation**

We provide crisis accommodation and transitional housing with 24/7 onsite support, offering a safe and stable environment where individuals and families can stabilise, recover and begin rebuilding their lives.

## **Youth homelessness support**

Our youth homelessness programs support young people aged 16–25 who are experiencing or at risk of homelessness, helping them access safe accommodation, education and employment pathways, mental health support and essential life skills.

## **Domestic and family violence safe housing**

We deliver safe, confidential housing for women and children escaping domestic and family violence, supported by trauma-informed case management that prioritises safety, dignity and long-term stability.

## **Tenancy support services**

Our tenancy support services assist individuals and families at risk of losing their homes through advocacy with landlords, budgeting and household management support, and early intervention to prevent homelessness.

## **Wrap-around support and life skills**

Across all programs, we provide personalised case management, mental health and wellbeing support, life-skills development, community connection, and pathways to education, training and employment opportunities.

Together, these services form an integrated housing and homelessness portfolio supporting Queenslanders in crisis and creating sustainable pathways to independence and long-term housing security.

## Leo's story

Leo was just 14 when he became homeless. He came from a good family with everything a child should need.

But he was battling an inner turmoil that caused a rift between him and his family, and was destroying his life.

When he found Anglicare, Leo says he was a young man without hope.

But little by little, with the support of Anglicare, Leo began to turn his life around. He'd arrive in the morning for a hot meal but stay for an hour-long chat with people who genuinely cared about how he was doing.

Anglicare gave Leo the basics of survival, like food, warm blankets and toiletries. Day-after-day, they also reminded him that his life had value.

Today, thanks to the support of kind people, like you, Anglicare has been able to assist Leo to obtain temporary housing. He's reconnected with his family and is focused on building his best future, one he nearly lost to homelessness.
