RE: Upcoming construction at EM Tooth and impact to access in our home

Dear residents and loved ones,

As part of our ongoing communication, I am writing to advise you of some upcoming construction works that may temporarily impact your access around our home.

Access around our home

- From **Wednesday 27 May 2026** the ambulance drop-off zone has moved underneath the new Port Cochere. Ambulances will access this area via the new ramp.
- **Please note**, the Port Cochere is for ambulance drop-off only.

Handover of main entry and car park

- We are pleased to share that full access to our main entry and car park is expected to be available from **Monday 1 June 2026**, pending weather.
- This means residents, families, visitors and our team members will be able to use the main entry and car park as normal.
- We thank you for your ongoing patience and understanding while our construction partners have carried out works in this area.

Electrical works

- From **Tuesday 2 June to Wednesday 3 June 2026**, construction workers will be completing cable works which will temporarily affect access to our pedestrian footpath as shown in the diagram on the page-over.
- Please note, a member of our construction team will be present throughout the duration of these works to ensure the safety of our residents and team members and to guide pedestrians around the driveway.

Temporary power outage to our home

- The next stage of cable works will involve connecting new cables into our home's main switchboard. This is scheduled to occur from **Tuesday 9 June 2026, between 3pm and 7pm**.
- During this time, there will be a full site power shutdown, and our home will operate on generator power. We do not anticipate any interruptions to our home while generator power is in use.

- The footpath will remain open while these works take place.
- **Please note**, reserved car parks will remain available exclusively for visitors who require accessible parking due to mobility needs.
